Jamail, at the age of 12 co-piloted his first flight with the Experimental Aircraft Association (EAA) Young Eagles Program. It was love at *first flight* and Jamail decided then to do whatever it took to continue flying. Unable to solo in the United States at the age of 14, he headed to Canada to become one of the youngest American pilots to solo a powered aircraft. At the age of 16,

Jamail became the National Spokesman for the EAA Vision of Eagles Program. At the age of 18 Jamail spreading his wings even farther branched out into aerobatic flying. He has flown with the Navy prestigious Blue Angels, been featured in the Franklin Institute and has received a Certificate of Special Recognition from the United States Congress. In the fall of 2004, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) signed Jamail as the first official Ambassador for Aviation and Space Education. He joined forces with Embry Riddle University and founded the Dream Launch Tour, a national tour designed to educate students about career opportunities in the aviation industry and to *motivate students to reach for their dreams.*
